Calvary Chapel High School Statements of Faith

Under God, and subject to biblical authority, the faculty and leaders of Calvary Chapel High School bear concerted witness to the following beliefs, to which they subscribe and hold essential to their ministry.

- 1. We believe** the Bible, Old and New Testaments, to be the inspired, only infallible, authoritative, inerrant Word of God (II Timothy 3:15; II Peter 1:21).
- 2. We believe** there is one God, eternally existent in three persons - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Genesis 1:1; Matthew 28:19; John 10:30).
- 3. We believe** in the deity of Christ (John 10:33); His virgin birth (Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:23; Luke 1:35); His sinless life (Hebrews 4:15; Hebrews 7:26); His miracles (John 2:11); His vicarious and atoning death (I Corinthians 15:3; Ephesians 1:7; Hebrews 2:9) His resurrection (John 11:25; I Corinthians 15:4); His Ascension to the right hand of the Father (Mark 16:19); and His future personal return in power and glory (Acts 1:11; Revelation 19:11).
- 4. We believe** in the absolute necessity of regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation because of the exceeding sinfulness of human nature. We are justified on the sole basis of faith in the shed blood of Christ and that only by God's grace and through faith alone are we saved (John 3:16-19; John 5:24; Romans 3:23; Romans 5:8-9; Ephesians 2:8-10; Titus 3:5).
- 5. We believe** in practicing the Lord's Supper and Water Baptism by immersion for born again believers in the same spirit as when Jesus introduced them to his disciples.
- 6. We believe** in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; those that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and those that are lost unto the resurrection of condemnation (John 5:28-29).
- 7. We believe** in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 8:9; I Corinthians 12:12-13; Galatians 3:26-28).
- 8. We believe** in the present ministry of the indwelling Holy Spirit, by which the responsive Christian is "enabled to live a godly and effective life as Christ's witnesses" (Romans 8:13-14; I Corinthians 3:16; I Corinthians 6:19-20; Ephesians 4:30; Ephesians 5:18).
- 9. We are a non-denominational church-sponsored school**, and invite other like-minded believers in Christ to join us in the education of our children. As a non-denominational church-sponsored school, we are not opposed to denominations, only the overemphasis of doctrinal differences that have led to division of the body of Christ.
- 10. We believe** the only true basis of Christian fellowship is Christ's "agape" love, which is greater than any differences we possess, and without which we have no right to claim ourselves Christians.
